Europe Unit guidance on integrated Masters degrees, Nov 05

 Europe Unit contact with individual HEIs, QAA, ECUK, Royal Society of Chemistry, Institute of Physics, Royal Pharmaceutical Society

 Incompatibility of integrated Masters with Bologna – no exit point after Bachelor and shorter duration

NB: Scotland 5yr integrated Masters



Europe Unit guidance on integrated Masters (cont.)

Recommended actions for HEIs:

- 60 ECTS at M' level (in line with Bologna Framework)
- Award both B' and M' certificates
- Terminology: 'integrated' not 'undergraduate'
- Diploma Supplement
- Extend the duration summer teaching, industrial placements



Europe Unit guidance on integrated Masters (cont.)

Promoting integrated Masters:

- Exacting output standards
- Benchmark statements
- Popularity with employers
- Highly selective
- In line with EU directive on recognition of professional qualifications
