The EPC early enrolments survey

- Annual survey undertaken of EPC members, anonymous, position relative to prior year, not precise figures
- Intention is to give members a sense of their position relative to national position
- UCAS provide applications data for undergraduates but not for postgraduates so poll gives an early "heads up" prior to official enrolment figures published 12 months+ after the event







Engineering: UG first degree (Nos. commencing in year)









UCAS applications to first degree programmes (as at June 2014)




Undergraduate applications to engineering for 2014/15 entry up 10.4% compared with 2013/14 and 17.1% compared with 2012/13.





Around 50 universities responded






EPC 2014/15 enrolments survey: response





Increase/decrease




EPC 2014/15 enrolments survey: university type

Increase/decrease compared with 2013/14








HEU undergraduates: all respondents, by discipline






Non EU undergraduates: all respondents, by discipline






HEU postgraduate (taught): all respondents, by discipline
