Flight Simulation and Universities Seminar

Wednesday 30 March 2016 at 1300 (Lunch from 1215) To be held at Thales UK Manor Royal, Crawley, near Gatwick

The Flight Simulation Group of the Royal Aeronautical Society will hold its annual seminar with Universities on 30 March 2016, hosted by Thales UK at Manor Royal, Crawley, near Gatwick (see map). This will provide an excellent opportunity to see some major parts of the UK's flight simulation industry in action. L3 Link Simulation & Training will also be involved.

The aim of the seminar is to foster flight simulation in universities by bringing together universities with an interest in flight simulation and the FSG, to exchange information and to encourage cooperation & collaboration between the FSG and Universities.

The FSG will outline its work and activities and universities will describe how they use their simulators in teaching and in research. The flight simulation industry will also be reviewed. University work of interest will come not only from Departments concerned with aeronautics but also from departments interested in systems, geographic information, human factors and visual and motion perception.

The Flight Simulation Group of the Royal Aeronautical Society exists to promote the science, art and engineering of flight simulation. In its scope, the FSG is unique. On the one hand it covers the design, manufacture, installation and operation of simulation equipment and synthetic environments. On the other it also addresses the economic and human factors which influence the use of simulators for research and development, and for civil and military flight crew training. The UK flight simulation industry is a major force world-wide.
