NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE is hereby given that the **Twenty-sixth Annual General Meeting** of the **Engineering Professors' Council** (a Company Limited by Guarantee registered in England & Wales 06791295) will be held **online via Zoom on Tuesday 14**th **July, 2020 at 3pm** immediately following the New Approaches Accreditation webcast (2-3pm).

This Notice is served in accordance with Articles 38-40 of the Engineering Professors' Council's Articles of Association.

WHAT HAPPENS AT THE AGM?

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) is required by our rules to transact the following business (in no particular order):

- The minutes of the last AGM
- The annual report and accounts
- The subscription levels for the following financial year
- Adoption of any special resolutions and ordinary resolutions as submitted (see deadlines below)
- The election of honorary officers, directors and Board members
- Other business as tabled by the Members

The AGM is the sovereign members' forum of the Engineering Professors' Council and is the body to which ordinarily the Board and Directors are held to account and required to report.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

- Each Institutional Member (i.e. a university or department that subscribes to the EPC) is entitled to nominate up to three Council Members who are entitled to vote at the AGM.
- All Individual Members of the EPC (i.e. all academic staff employed in member universities or other individuals who have been granted individual EPC membership) are welcome to attend as observers, but not vote unless they are also Council Members.
- One senior representative from each Partner organisation (i.e. the select few organisations recognised by the EPC as sharing common values and goals and invited to become Partners) are also entitled to attend, but they do not have voting rights.

No business shall be transacted at any meeting unless a quorum (twelve Council Members) is present. A resolution put to the vote of a meeting shall be decided on a show of hands. Proposals requiring amendment to the provisions of the Memorandum and Articles of Association (copies of which are available here) will necessitate a resolution of an Annual General Meeting, carried by a vote of not fewer than two-thirds of the Full Members present and voting at such a meeting, for which the quorum shall be 20 drawn from the Full Members.

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Council Members may submit resolutions and amendments to resolutions in line with the Companies Acts and the Articles of Association. If a Council Member wishes to place a special resolution to the Annual General Meeting, the draft resolution must be received by email to j.rich@epc.ac.uk no later than 09.00 on Wednesday 8th July 2020.

NOMINATIONS FOR ELECTION TO THE BOARD OF THE ENGINEERING PROFESSORS' COUNCIL

Honorary Vice President, President Elect and three elected Ordinary Board Members

On the occasion of the AGM, the period of office of the Honorary Vice President, President Elect, Professor Sarah Spurgeon will come to an end. This will result in a vacancy for the post for a term of office of one year from April 2020 until the EPC Annual General Meeting in 2021 when the holder of the post will be made Honorary President for the next two years followed by Honorary Vice President, Past President for a further year (a term of office of four years in total). Three elected positions for members of the EPC Board shall also fall vacant with a term of office of three years.

Elections (if required) shall be held during the 26th Annual General Meeting of the Engineering Professors' Council.

Any Individual Member of the EPC wishing to stand for these positions should indicate their intention using the form below. Nominations must reach Johnny Rich, Chief Executive, at j.rich@epc.ac.uk no later than 09.00 on Wednesday 8th July 2020. Johnny is happy to discuss the roles impartially and in confidence. Candidates should be nominated by a Council Member (an individual nominated by an Institutional Member as one of its representatives) and seconded by another Council Member by the deadline specified in the Notice of the Annual General Meeting using the form appended. This form will be circulated to those attending the AGM at which, in the event of more than three candidates, each Council Member will be invited to vote for their chosen candidate (by secret ballot). The three candidates with the highest number of votes will be elected. In the event of a tie, the President shall have the casting vote.

Only individuals from Institutional Members (i.e. universities) that have paid their subscription for the current academic year, by at least two weeks before the AGM, are eligible to stand for election and/or vote at the AGM.
